A Close Shave -scam warning!

One of our members advertised a Nova 1624 lathe for sale and was really pleased when someone emailed almost immediately and offered to buy, through PayPal, with no quibbling about the price. Several emails followed back and forth quite quickly. The buyer said he was from Scotland and would arrange for the lathe to be picked up. The seller, our member, was a little concerned about this and phoned around several friends who advised that he arrange delivery of the lathe, possibly sharing the freighting cost with the buyer. When the seller checked with a freight company the quote was £80 to £120 depending on postcode. On emailing the buyer to get a postcode there was no reply then or since. An acquaintance who works with PayPal said that this is a common scam where the "buyer" does pay his money to PayPal but then claims that the product wasn't received and reclaims the payment and keeps the product! Our member has subsequently sold the lathe to a cash buyer. BE AWARE especially if

using PayPal who are not at fault in this.
